

Dermal Fillers Pre & Post Care

Avoid taking medications that cause blood thinning or inhibit clotting such as, Aspirin & aspirin containing products for 7days. <u>Discuss with your PCP</u>

• Coumadin, Warfarin, Lovenox, Plavix, Pletal, Ticlid, Trental

Contraindications to Radiesse, Belotero & Juvederm include:

- 1. History of allergy or reaction to any component of the Radiesse Belotaro & Juvederm
- 2. Infection at proposed treatment sites
- 3. Active inflammatory process at proposed treatment sites
- 4. History of keloid formation or hypertrophic scarring
- 5. Pregnancy or breastfeeding
- 6. Current immunosuppressive therapy
- 7. If there is a history of facial cold sores, there is a risk of exacerbation. Please discuss with physician medications that may minimize the risk of recurrence.
- 8. Multiple injections might be made depending on the site and depth of the wrinkles.
- 9. After treatment, there will be moderate to severe swelling, some redness and bruising. These symptoms will resolve in about 7 days.

Filler POST CARE INSTRUCTIONS:

- Do NOT touch treated areas for 6 hours. After 6 hours, the areas can be gently washed.
- Do NOT massage treated areas for 48 hours.
- Do NOT exercise for 24 hours after treatment.
- Do NOT drink alcohol for 24 hours after treatment.
- Avoid excessive sun exposure, UV lamp exposure, tanning, and cold outdoor activities until redness and swelling resolve.
- After treatment, there will be moderate to severe swelling, some redness & bruising.
- These symptoms will resolve in about 7 days. Please contact office if these symptoms persist beyond 7 days.
- Ice frequently for comfort and to reduce swelling.
- Take Tylenol as needed for discomfort.
- Please schedule a follow up appointment in 2 weeks.
- Results vary from person to person; additional treatments may be necessary to achieve the desired level of correction.
- Periodic maintenance injections, generally within 1-2 years, will help sustain the desired level of correction
